

# Home Care

Kin On Home Care is licensed by the Washington Department of Health to provide home care services in King County. This program provides assistance with personal hygiene, daily living tasks, and household chores for physically challenged and chronically ill clients in an environment they are most familiar with – their own home.

### Services Include:

- **Personal Hygiene:** Assistance with bathing, body care, dressing and toileting
- **Daily Living:** Ambulation, transfer, positioning, eating, medication management, essential shopping and travel to medical services
- **Housework:** Assistance with dusting, vacuuming, laundry, linen changing and other services as needed

### Payment Methods:

Private Pay or State Funded Services with a two-hour minimum. State funded services include: COPEs Personal Care, Medicaid Personal Care, and In-Home Respite



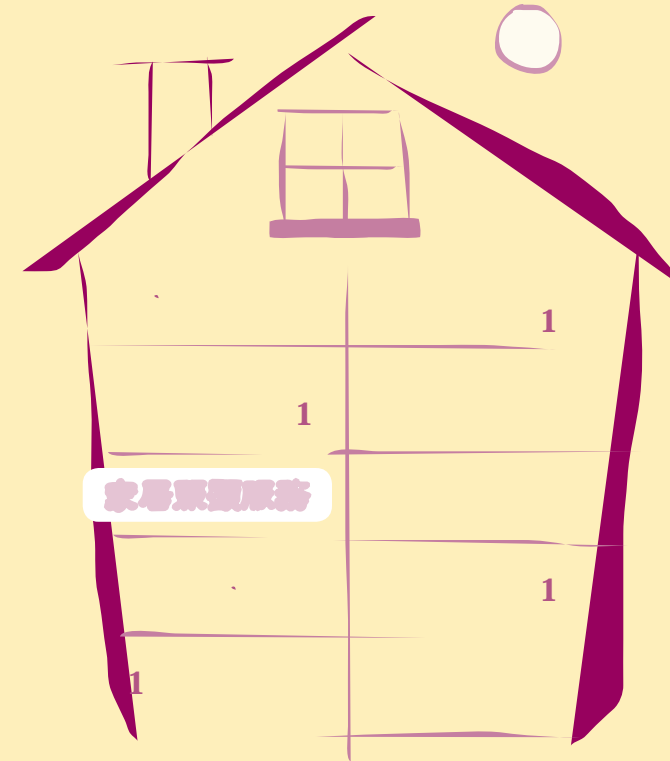
